Position:

We are seeking dedicated candidates who are compassionate, energetic, positive and take pride in their work. Currently, we have an opening for a Latinx Advocate. The Latinx Advocate assists clients from the Latinx community and will be assessing survivor services for victims/survivors of domestic violence, intimate partner violence, stalking, sexual assault, elder abuse, human trafficking and child abuse. Will also assist clients in identifying and obtaining available benefits and social and community services and will assist social workers with developing, organizing, and conducting programs to prevent and resolve problems relevant to substance abuse, human relationships, rehabilitation, or dependent care.

Your day may include these duties:

- Provide support and advocacy for clients; establish rapport and maintain a working relationship.
- Develop safety plans with clients, including housing, job skills development, financial literacy and other appropriate services.
- Keep records, prepare reports and memorandums concerning clients and consults with department concerning clients and program options.
- Be able to provide client transportation and accompany clients to court or other agency appointments where needed.

Requirements:

- Must be fully bilingual, with written and oral fluency in English and Spanish.
- Strong knowledge of the Latinx community.
- Knowledge of Trauma informed policies and procedures.
- A minimum of one year of experience providing direct services and/or advocacy to survivors of domestic violence/intimate partner violence or sexual assault, people who are economically disadvantaged or physically/mentally disabled, substance abuse/dual diagnosed individuals, the elderly, at-risk youth, or other vulnerable populations preferred.
- Ability to work with clients of all ages and backgrounds who have experienced trauma.
- Experience with Microsoft Office Suite (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.) and computer skills.
- Ability to learn new technologies and software.
